

Snowflake Mug

Ingredients

4110-Ice Cream Pint Mug Holder

FS2300-Polar Bear

FS2387-Pool Party

BD2500-Bumpy Snow

ColorStix-6 #6541 Soft Fan Brush
Sponge

Two different sized Snowflake
Punches (found at any craft store)

Directions

Step 1- Apply 2 coats of Pool Party to the outside of the mug and 3 coats to the handle and the inside of the mug using the soft fan brush. Let dry to the touch.

Step 2- Punch out the two different sized snowflakes using regular white copy paper. The snowflake needs to be pretty wet, so you will need to hold the snowflake in your fingers and dip the whole flake into water and apply to the outside of the mug onto the Pool Party. Dab with a sponge to get off the excess water that will drip. Scatter as many snowflakes as you would like around the outside of the mug applying each one the same way. **(Note: The paper has to be applied with a glaze under it as in this technique. It cannot stick directly to bisque because when the bisque dries it will fall off. If you want to do this technique right onto the bisque you would need to use contact paper instead of regular copy paper)**

Step 3- Using the soft fan brush apply 3 coats of Polar Bear to the outside of the mug going over all the snowflakes. Let dry to the touch and use a pin to lift off the snowflakes. **(Note: When doing this technique don't ever let the paper dry overnight as it is very hard to see where you put them once it completely dries)**

Step 4- Let dry and dip in Gare Dazzle Dip or Gare 9000D Dipping Glaze and fire to cone 06.
